

Carriageway Resurfacing Works - Phase 1

A412 St Albans Road

Works for this phase will be carried out in 2 areas between **A41 Dome Roundabout & Balmoral Road** and **Bedford Street & A411 Beechen Grove Roundabout**.

Between **Wednesday 28 August 2024** and **Thursday 5 September 2024**

Working times – 8pm to 5am (noise curfew of midnight)

We are writing to tell you about works we'll be undertaking in your area.

What you need to do:

- We need the road clear of parked vehicles to complete the work.
- **Driveways between the junctions mentioned above will not be accessible at any time during the closure. If you need to use your vehicle, please make sure you move it outside the road closure area shown on this letter, at least 30 minutes before we are due to start working.**
- **On street parking during the works within the closure will not be available.**

What you need to know:

- **Vehicles will not be allowed access through the road closure during the works. Please speak to the on-site team on the day who will be able to advise on residents' access or contact Eurovia on 07703 796403 or email us at hcc.comms@eurovia.co.uk.**
- Emergency vehicles will be always given access.
- Where it is safe to do so, the County Council may be able to exercise discretion in exceptional circumstances to meet its public sector equality duty.
- In order to create a safe environment for the workforce and members of the public alike, the works will be completed under a full road closure with a fully signed diversion route.

Advanced works information boards will be erected around the works area prior to works taking place. See details overleaf for working times.

- Please refer to the yellow signboards in your area to see the exact dates, timings, and permit number. Any date changes to these works will be communicated on the yellow signboards and at www.hertfordshire.gov.uk/roadclosures
- These works are weather dependent and may be postponed if poor weather is forecast.

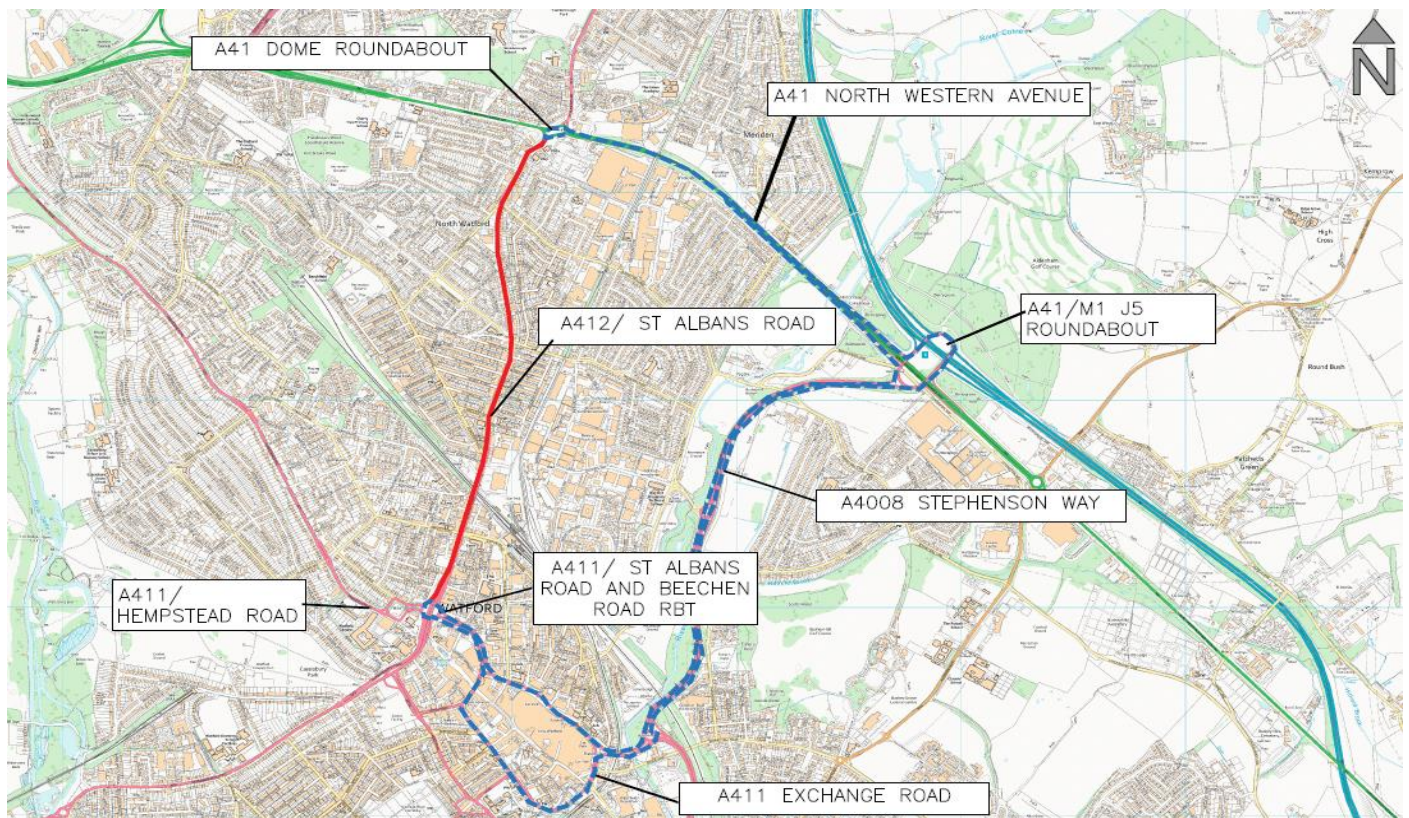
We are aware that other sections of A412 St Albans Road are in need of repair.

- **All traffic** to follow the A41 North Western Avenue/Colne Way, A41 Otterspool Way/Colne Way, A4008 Stevenson Way, A411 Exchange Road, A411 Beechen Grove, and A411 Town Hall Roundabout and vice versa. Please see the map on next page for more detail.
